 - Check that Capabilities display OSDP Readers = 4.

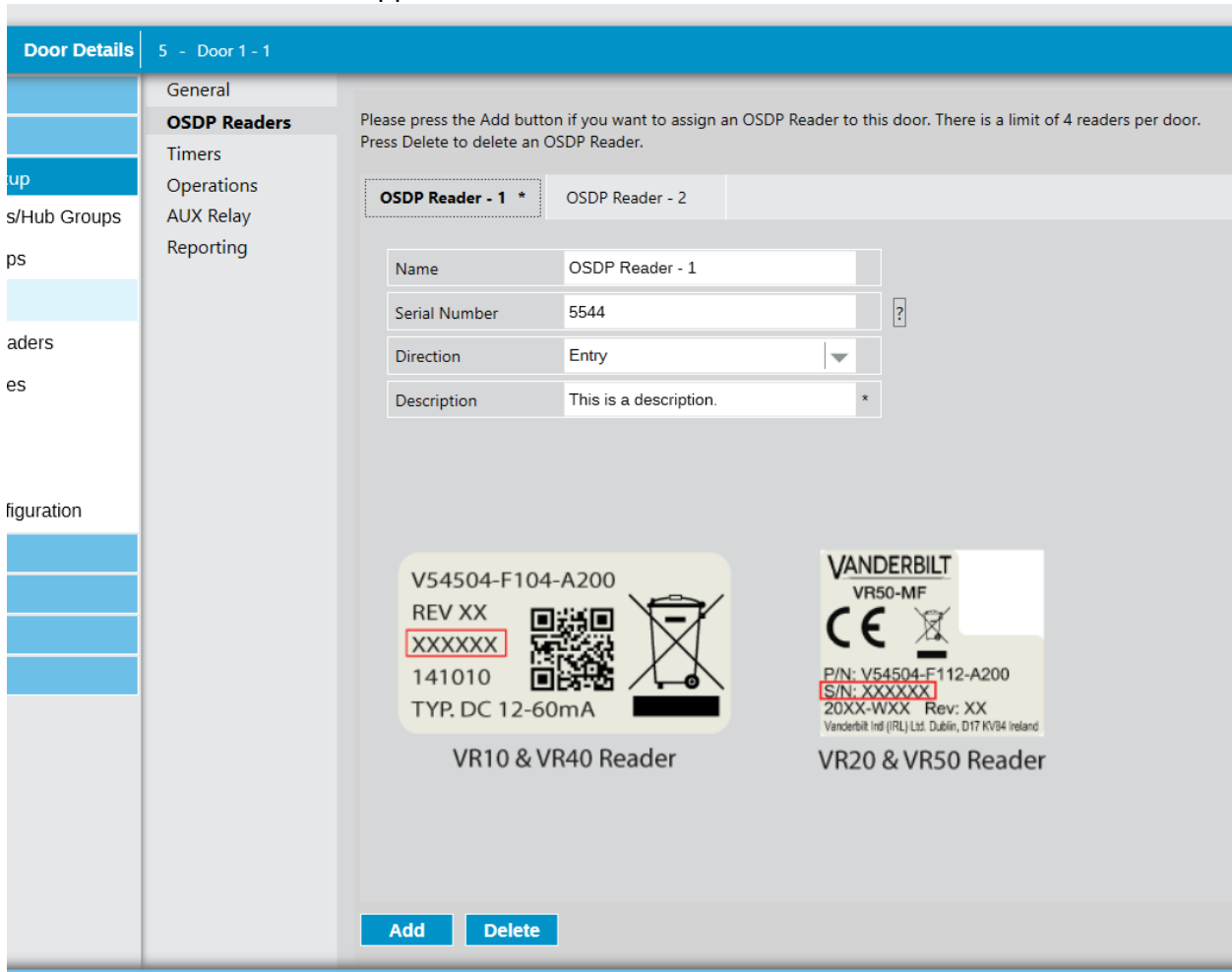
