By evolving to a video partner rather than a video manufacturer, we will be more flexible and agile as a customer-first company given the greater variety of video products that we can provide to match our flagship products.

This will enable us to focus our manufacturing efforts on our core strengths and engineer better high-performance solutions in access and intrusion, while simultaneously delivering 100% on your video needs by partnering with the best solutions in the field. We believe this forward-thinking approach will keep us on top of industry trends and bring creativity, efficiency, and competitiveness to our market approach.



Initially, our video partners include Hikvision, Milestone, and GVD.
